Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

Background:

The Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing released Ontario's rent increase guideline for 2017. The 2017 guideline amount will be 1.5%. This is a decrease from the 2.0% rent increase guideline amount in 2016.

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The annual guideline is the maximum amount that most landlords can increase a tenant's rent without making an application to the Landlord and Tenant Board. The 2017 guideline was calculated under the Residential Tenancies Act, 2006 and is based on the Ontario Consumer Price Index. Annual rent control guidelines are designed to recognize changes in building operating costs, so that housing providers can properly maintain properties and protect tenant health and safety, while at the same time ensuring that tenants can still pay their rent.

The 2017 guideline applies to a rent increase that takes effect between January 1, 2017 and December 31, 2017.

Action: Effective January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017, increases to market rent must not exceed 1.5% as per the 2017 Rent Control Guideline.
