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Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

Background:

The Ministry of Housing released Ontario's rent increase guideline for 2019. The 2019 guideline amount will be 1.8%. This amount is unchanged from the 1.8% rent increase guideline amount in 2018.

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Action:

The annual guideline is the maximum amount that most landlords can increase a tenant's rent without making an application to the Landlord and Tenant Board. The 2019 guideline was calculated under the Residential Tenancies Act, 2006 and is based on the Ontario Consumer Price Index. Annual rent control guidelines are designed to recognize changes in building operating costs, so that housing providers can properly maintain properties and protect tenant health and safety, while at the same time ensuring that tenants can still pay their rent.

The 2019 guideline applies to a rent increase that takes effect between January 1, 2019 and December 31, 2019.

Action: Effective January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019, increases to market rent must not exceed 1.8% as per the 2019 Rent Control Guideline.
