## EARLY LEARNING PLAY GROUP

This is a **FREE** drop-in style program for all parents and caregivers with children 0 - 6 years of age, to come together and explore, learn, create, and play in our child friendly spaces; talk to professionals in the Early Childhood field; and connect with others.

## PLAY DINE & DASH

Drop-in style, this **FREE** program is offered to all parents and caregivers with children 0 - 6 years of age. During this evening event participants are given the opportunity to explore, learn, and play before a meal is served to them.

## INFANT MASSAGE

Register for these **FREE** classes designed to help you build and strengthen the bond with your baby. Through guided sessions, you'll learn soothing massage techniques that support connection, communication, and trust—helping you better understand your baby's cues while creating calm, meaningful moments together.

## TINY TOTS TOGETHER

This **FREE** drop-in program is for parents and caregivers with children under the age of 18 month, to connect with each other, share stories, advice and support, while playing with your children in an environment designated for your little one.

## FAMILY ENRICHMENT

Registration is required to participate in this **FREE** program, that offers parents a break from their children, so they can further their education in parenting and personal life skills. Children are cared by staff and volunteers while parents attend class.
