EARLY LEARNING PLAY GROUP

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PLAY DINE & DASH

Drop-in style, this **FREE** program is offered to all parents and caregivers with children 0 – 6 years of age. During this evening event participants are given the opportunity to explore, learn, and play before a meal is served to them.
