




# District of Nipissing Pre-Kindergarten Experiences Survey (PKES)



To gain a better understanding of the overall health and well-being of children and families within the District of Nipissing, this voluntary survey examined the environment, relationships, services and other aspects of daily life.

The estimated response rate of the survey was approximately 7% therefore, caution should be used when interpreting the results and should not be used to draw conclusions for the entire district.



### Screen time (phone, TV, video games etc.)



Nearly 1/2 of children spend an hour or more on electronics during a regular week day, climbing to more than 3/4 of children on the weekends.


### Top 5 activities that children are engaging in on a daily basis with their loved ones:

- Talking about their day.....95%
- Telling/reading stories.....73%
- Singing songs or rhymes.....66%
- Doing household chores.....65%
- Getting help with letter sound...60%

## Family Demographics



Although 28% identified as Francophone, only 11% reported French as their first language at home



89% of respondents identified English as their first language.

87% of respondents are mothers  
83% are from a 2 parent household  
85% of respondents completed post secondary education

Families worried about whether food would run out before they had enough money to buy more

Sometimes (16%)    Often (9%)

7% accessed a food bank in the past year

### 53% work full time

Of those who work full time: 13% work from home, while 72% are spending 25 - 49 hours away from home per week for work (including commute)

### 11% work part time

Of those who work part time: 36% work from home, while 50% reported spending 25 - 49 hours away from home per week for work (including commute)
