The position determines initial and on-going client eligibility according to HPP Guidelines; develops, implements and monitors a Housing Stability and/or Sustainability Plan in conjunction with each citizen and/or Community Homelessness Service Provider; manages an assigned caseload of HPP services recipients. This position also actively engages with Community partners.

Qualifications:

- Minimum post-secondary Diploma in Mental Health and Addictions or related field or acceptable combination of education and experience;
- Up to two (2) years previous experience in a Social Services delivery environment, such as but not limited to: Ontario Works, ODSP and Housing Services;
- Good working knowledge of the Housing/Homelessness Legislation & Regulations;
- Good working knowledge of Community Service Providers;
- Good working knowledge of 10 Year Housing and Homelessness Plan, Poverty Reduction Strategy;
- Good verbal and written communication skills, organizational skills, negotiation skills, motivational skills and conflict resolution skills; excellent customer service skills;
- Proficiency in the use of computers;
- General knowledge of the full range of programs delivered by DNSSAB including: Ontario Works, Child Care, Affordable Housing and Emergency Medical Services;
- Must possess a Valid Ontario Driver's License and a reliable vehicle for use on the job;
- Respect confidentiality.

Must be legally eligible to work in Canada. Police Record Check within three (3) months is a requirement. Proof of Vaccination is a requirement.
